#### Enter Your Canvas Course:

1. Sign in to Canvas and navigate to the **CPP Instant Access eBook** link from the navigation area on the left-hand side of your course.

**Please note, this may be in a different location based on your instructor's preference.**

2. This will open your Launch dashboard where you can opt-out of the material if you are within the opt-out deadline, or engage with your course materials.

Click the **Reveal Access Code** button to open the drawer on the right-hand side, where you can copy your access code, and access your redemption URL through the **More Info** field.

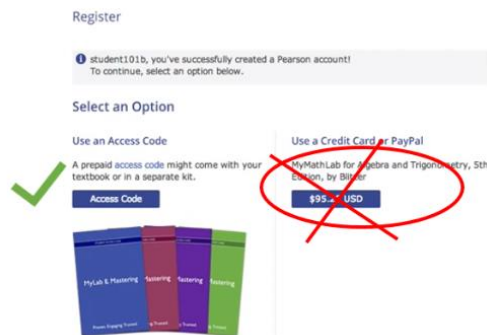

1. Enter your Pearson account **username** and **password** to **Link Accounts**.
