VitalSource BookShelf for Faculty:

VitalSource knows that faculty want students to have access to quality learning materials that lead to successful learning outcomes. Their platform for distributing, accessing, consuming and engaging with those materials is Bookshelf by VitalSource. More than just an eReader, Bookshelf is a personalized digital learning experience that allows faculty to do more with learning materials, whether those are e-texts or courseware, and regardless of whether students are purchasing on their own or receiving access via the Instant Access program.

Digital Desk Copies/Sampling:

Faculty can request "sampling" access, essentially a digital review/desk copy, of nearly all VitalSource e-texts for no charge. Just go to <u>https://www.vitalsource.com/educators</u>, sign up for faculty access, and request access for the book/s you need!

VitalSource Studio:

We have always supported faculty who create their own course materials or curate course-packs through our partnership with Graphics & Printing Services. These low-priced interactive books are meant to combine the adaptability and affordability of OER with the attractive features of publishers' digital platforms, including interactive homework/quizzing and LMS integration. 'Default' Adoptions for Multi-Section Courses Reminder

Do you teach a section or sections of a large multi-section course where the standard adoption for a book + courseware bundle was made by the department or a committee rather than individual faculty? Please help us provide accurate information to students by letting us know whether you actually use all the pieces in that bundle in your sections. If you use just the book, we will only list that for your section. If you use alternate materials, we will list those instead of the 'default' materials.

Why is this important? When the 'default' adoption isn't really what students need, it causes confusion and hassle for students (and us!). We want students to have confidence that what we have listed is what they really need to succeed in that class, and they won't have to worry about paying for materials they do not need. The Disability Resource Center also needs to know if they are providing accessible versions for the correct materials.

We understand that at the time adoptions are due by HEOA standards, which individual faculty are teaching which specific sections may not be known. But by the time our students start shopping for their materials, we need to have the <u>correct</u> information posted.

Departments can include a note with adoptions for these classes if individual faculty are allowed to deviate so that we can try to follow up. We ask individual faculty in these courses to make sure the information posted for their students is accurate and let us know if we need to update that information. If you teach a section of a large multi-section course but use different materials/ courseware than the 'standard' adoption, let us know as soon as you have your section assignments.
